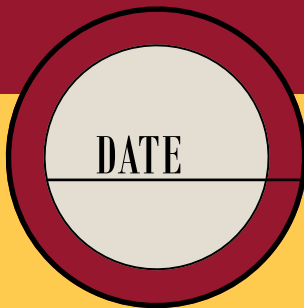

Achieving Independence Through Employment

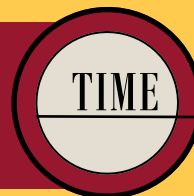
Sponsored by the DARS-Office for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Services
