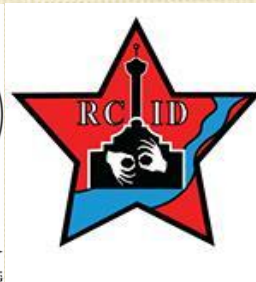
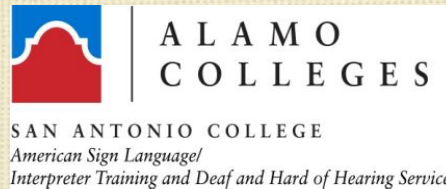
KERI RICHARDSON, NAD V, CI/CT, SC: L, TCDHH Level V & Court
