Aug 10, 2022 Arrival in Ireland - Limerick

Cead mile failte! A hundred-thousand welcomes! After checking into your hotel in Limerick, free time to relax and perhaps enjoy the hotel's leisure amenities or explore the city. Tonight, meet your Tour Director and travel companions for a welcome dinner at your hotel. (D)

Aug 11, 2022 Excursion to Cliffs of Moher - Galway - Rathbaun Farm

Your vacation starts in earnest with a drive to the breathtaking CLIFFS OF MOHER, rising 668 feet above the Atlantic Ocean, to savor the magnificent panorama of the Clare coast. Then, visit Galway, a popular seaside destination and a buzzing cosmopolitan center with colorful shops and a busy cafe and bar culture. And finally, visit RATHBAUN FARM and learn from the farmer about sheep shearing and dog whistling. Today's driving distance: 159 mi (B)

Aug 12, 2022 Limerick -Adare - Ring of Kerry - Killarney

A day full of splendid scenery. Head south and stop at quaint Adare with its pretty thatched cottages. At Killorglin, join the famous RING OF KERRY for a 100-mile panoramic drive around the island's southwestern tip. Plenty to focus your camera on here: sparkling seascapes, mountains dotted with brightly colored farmhouses, winding lanes bordered with subtropical vegetation, and the breathtaking panorama of the Lakes of Killarney from Ladies View. Overnight is in the popular resort of Killarney. Today's driving distance: 157 mi (B, D)

Aug 13, 2022 Killarney – Blarney – Cahir - Dublin

On the way to Dublin, stop in Blarney, renowned for its castle and magical Kissing Stone. Then we continue our drive with a photo stop in Cahir. Then we continue to Dublin, Ireland's capital city. Today's driving distance: 225 mi (B)

Aug 14, 2022 Dublin

The morning orientation drive in the "Fair City" includes statue-lined O'Connell Street, elegant Georgian squares, St. Patrick's Cathedral, and Oscar Wilde's Trinity College. The afternoon is at leisure for you to enjoy this vibrant city. (B)

Aug 15, 2022 Dublin - Northern Ireland - Giant's Causeway - Belfast

Cross the Boyne River and continue to the awe-inspiring GIANT'S CAUSEWAY, renowned for its polygonal columns of layered basalt, and the only UNESCO World Heritage Site in Northern Ireland. The next destination is Belfast with a visit of the fascinating TITANIC EXHIBITION. Learn all about the building of the largest passenger steam ship, its maiden voyage, and the tragic night of April 14, 1912. Today's driving distance: 216 mi (B)

Aug 16, 2022 Belfast - Edinburgh, Scotland

First thing this morning, board your FERRY and cross the North Channel to Cairnryan on Scotland's southwest coast, and continue through the scenic Scottish border country to Edinburgh. Today's driving distance: 132 mi (B)

Aug 17, 2022 Edinburgh

Morning city sightseeing with a local expert who introduces you to the 200-year-old "New Town", famous Scottish scientists, inventors, and novelists. In the "Old Town," drive up the narrow Royal Mile to EDINBURGH CASTLE to admire Scotland's Crown Jewels. The afternoon is free to enjoy the Scottish capital at your own pace. Later, a unique experience: Attend the world-renowned Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo performance. (B)

Aug 18, 2022 Edinburgh - Alnwick, England - York

This morning at ALNWICK CASTLE the choice is yours: visit the CASTLE itself, the opulent ancestral home of the Duke and Duchess of Northumberland, or explore ALNWICK GARDEN, where the fountains and waterfalls are a breathtaking feature. In York, England's most complete medieval city, follow your Tour Director through a maze of quaint streets, including the narrow Shambles. Today's driving distance: 243 mi (B)

Aug 19, 2022 York - Stratford-Upon-Avon - Bath

Head for Stratford-upon-Avon with a photo stop at Anne Hathaway's Cottage, then visit SHAKESPEARE'S BIRTHPLACE. In the afternoon, drive to the elegant Georgian city of Bath. Explore the amazing excavations of the ROMAN BATHS and walk where Romans walked 2,000 years ago. Today's driving distance: 286 mi (B, D)

Aug 20, 2022 Bath - Stonehenge - London

The first stop will be Stonehenge. Try to figure out the intriguing riddle of STONEHENGE, the most famous monument of prehistoric Europe. Then, we continue to London, the final destination of the itinerary. Today's driving distance: 131 mi (B)

Aug 21, 2022 London

The morning sightseeing tour via bus (no inside visits) with a Local Guide includes all the following landmarks: the Houses of Parliament and Big Ben beside the Thames River, Westminster Abbey, Whitehall and the Prime Minister's Downing Street residence, Piccadilly Circus, Buckingham Palace. Free time in the afternoon. (B)
