Track & Workshop descriptions: Participants choose from Track I, II, or III

Track I: Certified Lay Servant Basic - Karen Miller (10 Hours, Friday & Saturday). This course is an introduction to the Certified Lay Servant ministry of the United Methodist Church that has been adapted for and by Deaf and users of American Sign Language.

Track I: Certified Lay Servant Advanced - Carol Stevens (10 hours, 5 Friday & Saturday). Must have completed the Basic CLS, this course specializes in ministry that is of and by Deaf people in the UMC.

Track II: Choose up to four workshops or activities from the following six choices:

United Methodist Church Leadership 101, (2 hours) Presented by Rev. Leo Yates and Mary Ann Deters This workshop presents typical UMC leadership committees from the local church to the annual conference, better enabling persons to consider participating in leadership roles.

Pastoral Care 101, Presented by Rev. Leo Yates and Mary Ann Deters (2 hours)

Jesus emphasized the importance of compassion. In this workshop, participants will receive an overview of pastoral care and some techniques to provide care and compassion to others in their church and community.

Global and Local Mission leadership - (2 hours, Friday, or Saturday) Rev. Dr. Kirk VanGilder, Associate Professor of Religion and Philosophy at Gallaudet University, Kirk has expertise in Deaf mission abroad (Zimbabwe, Kenya, Turkey) and locally.

Finding your Spiritual Gifts (2 hours, Friday, or Saturday). Rev. Dr. Kirk VanGilder An ordained elder in the Baltimore Washington Conference, Kirk has led workshops on helping Deaf discover their spiritual gifts for lay ministry.

Demystifying the Bible - (2 hours, Friday, or Saturday) - Rev. Dr. Tom Hudspeth How do we read the Bible, what did the Bible mean to the first people who heard or read the scriptures? What does the Bible say to us today? For anyone who wants to know more about the Bible.

Making Tamales – (2 hour shifts, Saturday) Join in making traditional tamales with the people of Christ Foundry, a Spanish-speaking mission church of the North Texas Conference, a neighboring church about 8 minutes from Walnut Hill. Limited to three groups of 8 persons, each group will serve 2 hours. Transportation from Walnut Hill to Christ Foundry will be provided.

Track III: Interpreter Track: "Weddings, Funerals and Sermons: Interpreting Christian Content" (CEU's Pending 5 hours, Saturday). Peggy Cobb. Leader, Elisa Baysinger, host. This is an introduction for interpreters and students of interpreting on how best to translate Christian weddings, funerals, and sermons into ASL.
